Greetings Families (Both new and established members),

I hope you will enjoy the following [playing-year] year-end report and Summer Newsletter.

Below, summarize, are our past actions and future projections of club operations, with an overall club goal to assure continued stability, growth and opportunity for our players for years to come.

A New Beginning:

In just our first re-organized year as a CASL team for this area, your *Charlotte Soccer Club* (formerly *The Scorpions*), have pursued an agenda of progress to grow and stabilize our organization for years to come with the following foundational actions. Our first major action was a rebranding of the organization, to reflect our civic pride, by including coloration and theme, to emulate our school district with *Oriole Pride!* Oriole spirit runs deep in our area, so too does the love of soccer. We also grew our organization from a sunsetting, one team, one gender model to a variety of seven teams in our first season alone(19 players, to 85 players total), securing a future for soccer in our town!

First, we formed a non-profit, elected board and became a known entity in the county. We later achieved our 501(c)3 status with the IRS; this allows our organization to do a larger variety of fundraiser opportunities to enrich our organizational experience for players, and keep costs down. We also secured a P.O. Box at our local post office and established a Facebook page/presence, and formed a customized and well functioning website(https://www.charlottesoccerclub.org/).

A special shout-out to our local school district, as it has been *pivotal* in allowing usage of facilities for our teams, year round. A community wide effort is underway to give our young athletes the best experience possible, with access to all essential resources available in the area. On this same note, I also wish former board members, and coaches leaving the organization the best on their quest to find their happiness elsewhere as our core continues to expand and thrive in the service of our membership.

The Year Ahead:

In this current off-season(June to Mid-August), our Vice Presidents' of Travel, Finance, Registration ,and Communications, and their committees, have been busy with many actions to prepare for the 2025-2026 playing year. Our actions have included fundraisers, yearly CASL mandated tryouts with team placements, as well as a full equipment inventory. The goal of equipping teams with all essential team gear is in process; this goal includes our previous teams and newly formed teams in the 2025-2026 year. Speaking of new teams, we have formed an additional three teams for the 2025-2026 seasons. That puts our organization at a total of ten

fully rostered teams, ready to grow and battle in the fall and spring season for our club and the Charlotte community. Our new total player enrollment going into the 2025-2026 playing year in CASL is near 130 active players (An increase from 19 to 130, in one year! That's a 584% increase)! *The word is out, this is a special organization to be part of and grow in!*

Closing Comments:

It's been a pleasure to lead this all volunteer organization through its transformation, and into our future this past year and onward. I think fondly of the endless efforts of our volunteers, coaches, and board members this last year. So many hours and cold dinners have been had to form our organization into a <u>first class operation</u>. Together, we are actualizing change, growth, for all of our kids, together, as a community.

2. Payment of Club Dues

Club Dues for the year are set at \$200.00, for the entire year.
 Due 8/5/2025, at the Registration Party, or before.

This includes the following:

- 1. CASL Dues
- 2. Referee Fees for all home games
- 3. Full Uniform (Home, Away, Shorts and Socks)
- 4. Team/Field Equipment Funding (Balls, pinnies, Cones, painting fields, benches, corner flags...etc.)
- 5. Club Costs (Insurance, promotions, website maintenance, and PO Box costs).
- Ways to pay your <u>dues in full on 8/5</u> at the Registration Day:
 - Preferably, write a Personal Check/Money Order to: Charlotte Soccer Club
 - 2. *Cash* is accepted, with receipt, at the Registration Party.
 - Venmo the following amount (You must include the processing fee[3%] in the total, or the amount will not be fully paid), at \$206 if paying through VENMO, only.

- 4. Optional Payment Plan (Please communicate this option at Registration Day, with the Finance Table [VP-Finance Shetenhelm or President Xanthopoulos].
 - First payment due date: 8/5 of \$100 per player
 - Second and final payment: 9/2 of \$100 per player.
 - These two payments must be paid before the first game. Please reach-out if you have any challenges. We're here to help kids play! (See below)
- 5. Financial Aid is available through the following two sources for families in need. (Important to note: Receiving Financial aid, does require three(3) hours of volunteering, per season, per player, toward club activities):
 - CASL Financial Aid(Apply here First): Up to \$75
 costs covered, for one season. This financial aid is maxed
 at three players per team and MUST be reapplied for the
